The Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (“PUCN”) is seeking a graduate student or a recent graduate interested in the energy sector for a 10-week internship for the Regulatory Operations, Resource Market and Analysis Division.

**The Key Areas of Responsibility:**

The intern will be working in Regulatory Operation, Resource and Market Analysis Division, with various professionals from various fields including economist, engineers, financial analyst and legal staff to conduct economic, quantitative and public policy analysis of regulated utilities including electric, natural gas, water/sewage and local telephone companies. Specifically, the intern’s tasks will include, but not limited to:

- Evaluating the cost effectiveness of energy efficiency and conservation (“EE&C”) programs proposed by an electric and gas utilities.
- Assessing the cost effectiveness of demand response (“DR”) programs proposed by an electric utility.
- Reviewing the past performance of the EE&C and DR programs.

The intern will also have the opportunity to:

- Learn issues related to an electric utility’s integrated resource plan, which includes load forecasting and an economic analysis of alternative long-term resource plans as proposed by an electric utility.
- Witness and attend official Commission hearings and proceedings on issues before the Commission, as well as observe and participate in meetings with regulated utilities.

**Skills Required:**

Must be professional, well-organized and work in a collaborative team environment with other economists, engineers, financial analyst, utility analysts and legal staff.

**Education/Qualifications:**

The internship is open to students currently enrolled in a masters/graduate level program or recently graduated (in the past 12 months). Areas of Interest include but are not limited to Economics, Finance, Public Policy, or a related field.

**Stipend:**

The intern will receive a stipend from NARUC while working for the PUCN in various areas of energy regulation. NARUC will provide a stipend of \$5,000 payable directly to the intern in two installments for a 10-week internship. NARUC requires that the intern prepare a short report at the end of the internship, detailing work activities and accomplishments.

**Position Location:** The position will be located in Carson City, Nevada.
