 - Use the drop box in the driveway of the Public Works Department at 1120 Airport Road, Minden,
 - Make an online payment from the Douglas County website at www.douglascountynv.gov.
- Many of you may be experiencing not only health uncertainty, but also financial
 uncertainty as a result of COVID-19. To assist during this time, Douglas County Utility
 will suspend service disconnections for non-payment for our customers directly impacted
 by this crisis. We will also waive late fees for customers who experience financial
 hardships related to COVID-19 or are unable to pay due to self-isolation. If this applies

 arrangements.
