## **Section II - Cost Proposal**

RMI and RAP propose to complete this project for a lump sum of \$89,000, paid by the State of Nevada. This amount is a partial request for funding to cover time and materials required for the work, which will be supplemented by additional funding we may secure from philanthropic, non-partisan sources.

The table below provides a more complete estimate of total staff hours and associated costs that we expect to incur in the course of this project. It includes the cost of seven total person-trips for RMI (six person-trips for three workshops [two people per workshop], plus an additional trip of 1-2 RMI staff members for additional PUCN support). Additionally, it includes the cost of seven total person-trips for RAP (five person-trips for three workshops [1-2 people per workshop], plus two additional person-trips by RAP staff for additional PUCN support).

As required by the RFP, RMI can prepare budgets prior to the start of each phase for PUCN review if selected.

As noted in Part I – Technical Proposal, we propose for RMI to serve as the primary vendor to the PUCN, while RAP will be a subcontractor to RMI. For contract and invoicing purposes, RMI will be the contract administrator with the PUCN and will separately manage billing and payment with RAP.

As noted above, RMI and RAP are seeking additional funding support from our partners and external sources to support this work. We may seek letters of endorsement or other support from the PUCN to help secure these funding opportunities.
