On January 20, 2015, Utilities, Inc. of Central Nevada (“UICN”) filed an Application with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (“Commission”) for approval of the first amendment to the Action Plan of the 2014 Integrated Resource Plan for water and sewer services as it relates to the reclaim water disposal site project, and requesting to designate two system improvement projects as eligible projects for which a system improvement rate may be established (“IRP Amendment”). This matter has been designated as Docket No. 15-01029.

This Notice serves only to notify the public that the Commission has received the above-referenced filing. It is the responsibility of interested persons to review the filing and monitor the proceedings to determine their desired levels of involvement based on how this matter may affect their unique situations. The details provided below are for informational purposes only and are not meant to be an all-inclusive overview of the filing.

The Application is filed pursuant to the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”), Chapters 703 and 704, including but not limited to NRS 704.661, and NAC 704.5683 through 704.5687.

In the Application, UICN specifically requests that the Commission: (1) approve the IRP Amendment; (2) issue a finding that the projects proposed in the IRP Amendment are prudent and that any future investment or expense associated with these projects be deemed a prudent investment for which UICN may recover all just and reasonable costs; (3) approve UICN's request to designate the following two action plan projects as eligible for System Improvement Rate: (a) the conversion of the overflow ponds to Rapid Infiltration Basins and (b) the filtration upgrade to cloth media filters; and (4) grant any further relief that the Commission deems just and reasonable.

Interested and affected persons may file petitions for leave to intervene pursuant to NAC 703.578 through 703.600, or notices of intent to participate as a commenter pursuant to NAC 703.491 at either of the Commission's offices on or before WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 25, 2015.

A person who submits a timely notice of intent to participate as a commenter may thereafter file written comments pursuant to NAC 703.491. A commenter is not a party of record and shall not take any action that only a party of record may take. Pursuant to NAC 703.500, only parties of record are entitled to enter an appearance, introduce relevant evidence, examine and cross-examine witnesses, make arguments, make and argue motions and generally participate in the proceeding.
