Service Lists Allow Anyone to Follow A Proceeding

The PUCN maintains three official service lists as a means of keeping interested persons informed of open proceedings and agenda meetings. To subscribe to a service list, submit a service list request form online at [puc.nv.gov/About/Docs/Forms/Service_List_Requests_\(Subscribe_or_Unsubscribe\)/](https://puc.nv.gov/About/Docs/Forms/Service_List_Requests_(Subscribe_or_Unsubscribe)/). Read the descriptions below to determine which service list, if any, you'd like to be placed on. You may subscribe to multiple service lists.

MASTER SERVICE LIST REQUEST

Subscribers to a master service list may choose to receive:

- Notification of all notices and orders issued in PUCN rulemaking dockets.
- Notification of all initial notices issued for new dockets before the PUCN.
- Notification of initial notices issued for new dockets regarding a specific utility type (electric, gas, telecom, water, and railroad).
- Notification of initial notices issued for new dockets regarding a specific utility company specialty list (Sierra Pacific Power Company, Nevada Power Company, Renewable List, and 252 Interconnection/Resale List).

Subscribers could receive multiple emails or mailings monthly depending on notification selections. If you choose to be on a master service list, you will be notified when an initial notice is issued that pertains to the utility type or utility company of interest. In order to receive additional notices and orders, you must request in writing to be on the service list for

Business Process Services (BPS) is responsible for the PUCN's core business processes relating to docket management. BPS scans all relevant documents into the appropriate dockets, manages service lists, coordinates the issuance of orders and the publication of notices, provides reception services, prepares agenda meeting notices and minutes, and maintains the PUCN's master calendar.

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that specific docket (see item #3 below). Subscribers to the rulemaking list will receive notification of all notices and orders issued in rulemaking dockets.

Subscribers may receive notification either by email or U.S. postal mail. Email subscribers will receive notification that an order or notice has been issued and is available to view on the PUCN's website. However, the actual notice or order will not be included as an attachment to the email. U.S. postal subscribers will receive a hard copy of the notice or order in the mail.

DOCKET-SPECIFIC SERVICE LIST REQUEST

Subscribers to this list will receive notification of all notices and orders specific to a selected open docket before the PUCN. Subscribers could receive multiple emails or mailings monthly depending on activity within the selected docket.

Subscribers may receive notification either by email or U.S. postal mail. Email subscribers will receive notification that an order or notice has been issued and is available to view on the PUCN's website. However, the actual notice or order will not be included as an attachment to the email. U.S. postal subscribers will receive a hard copy of the notice or order in the mail.

REQUEST FOR PUBLIC MEETING NOTICES

Subscribers to this list will receive notice of PUCN agenda meetings.

Subscribers may choose to receive notification either by email or U.S. postal mail. Email subscribers will receive the notices as PDF attachments. U.S. postal subscribers will receive a hard copy of the notice in the mail.
