Weatherization Assistance Program

PROGRAM BASICS

The [Nevada Housing Division's Weatherization Assistance Program](#) helps income-qualified families improve the energy efficiency of their homes. Households earning at or below 200% of the federal poverty level, as defined by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget, may be eligible.

For approved homeowners and renters, all services are provided at no direct cost. The program's mission is to lower utility bills, conserve energy, and enhance the health and safety of each dwelling unit.

Note: Owners of eligible rental properties may be responsible for covering 50% of the cost for capital improvements.

ENERGY CONSERVATION MEASURES

Once a licensed energy auditor completes a home energy assessment, eligible households may qualify for a range of upgrades designed to improve comfort, safety, and efficiency. Common improvements include:

-  Air sealing to reduce drafts and heat loss
-  Installation of energy-efficient LED lighting
-  Added insulation to maintain indoor temperatures
-  Low-flow shower heads to conserve water
-  Solar screens to block heat from windows
-  Weather-stripping to seal doors and windows

Additional upgrades, such as HVAC systems, refrigerators, and water heaters may be repaired or

replaced based on program criteria. These measures are selected to enhance energy efficiency, promote health and safety, and lower monthly utility costs.

How to Find a Docket on the PUCN Website

DOCKETS

The PUCN assigns a docket number to all new filings (applications, petitions, rulemakings, investigations, etc.). The docket number serves as a unique identifier for the matter.

After a docket has been assigned, all subsequent documents filed by any party (such as comments or testimony) or issued by the PUCN (such as notices and orders) in the course of the proceedings are identified by the same docket number and can be located using the docket number.

DAILY FILINGS REPORT AND WEEKLY NOTICE SUMMARY

For the **Daily Filings Report**, change the "Search Type" to "PUC - Public Search - Daily Filings Report."

For the **Weekly Notice Summary**, change the "Search Type" to "PUC - Public Search - Weekly Notice Summary."

ALTERNATE SITE TO LOOK UP DOCKETS

Use the PUCN's legacy [PUCN All Dockets](#)* web page to find a docket. The "CTRL + F" search function allows for a keyword lookup for a company or a regulation topic.

Example: Search for "rate case" to find the docket number associated with NV Energy's latest rate case (Docket 25-02016). Then head to [PUCN Document Search](#) and enter the docket number in the "Docket Number" field to view documents filed in the case.
